



Habitat To Build Six Homes in One Week

Build six homes in just one week, that's the goal for Wichita's Habitat for Humanity. The homes will be the start of the new Habitat South Village, a neighborhood the non-profit organization is building near 43rd Street and South Hydraulic.

"Wonder Week 2010" will be held from June 17th to June 25th. During that week Habitat volunteers will try to build and finish the neighborhood's first six homes. Help will come from local businesses, groups and other volunteers.

Wonder Week will also include the Blitz Home Builders, a group of volunteers from across the country who choose one project to help each year. The same group helped Wichita's Habitat for Humanity build four homes in one week back in 2006.

Ultimately the Habitat South Village will have 45 homes for 45 low-income families. Habitat officials say the families will pay some \$50,000 annually in taxes. Organization officials also say through private donations and grants, the funds are in place and work is already underway on infrastructure for the project. Those are things like sewers, water lines and streets.
